## *Prayer and Care—July 2019*


**We have been asked to pray for the various needs of...**

### PWRDF

Maison Dorcas is part of the Panzi Foundation, established in 2008 by Nobel Peace Prize winner Dr. Denis Mukwege in South Kivu, a province of the Democratic Republic of Congo where the rate of sexual and gender-based violence is the third highest among the 25 provinces. These crimes are rarely reported for fear of repercussions and stigma. Maison Dorcas is a safe haven for victims of violence and those needing extended medical care. Women at Maison Dorcas participate in their own decision-making, empowering them and building up their self-esteem. PWRDF, an arm of the Anglican Church of Canada, supports Maison Dorcas in providing women with literacy, numeracy and small business training.
