**In-Church Worship:** Because seating is limited to 50 to ensure physical distancing, you must register by contacting the office (email preferred) at [office@ascensionlondon.com](mailto:office@ascensionlondon.com) or 519-451-7780 each week, **by Thursday at noon**. Masks are mandatory. Online worship will continue on YouTube for those unable to attend.

**We need to keep an accurate list on file of all those who attend any given Sunday.** If you are on the worship schedule for clergy, music, usher, reader, AV, chancel, counter or warden on duty you will automatically be included as registered for that Sunday. If you change places please let the office know. If someone is attending with you, that person will need to register.

**Clergy Pastoral Care:** please either call the Clergy directly or call the office and the information will be passed on to the Clergy team.

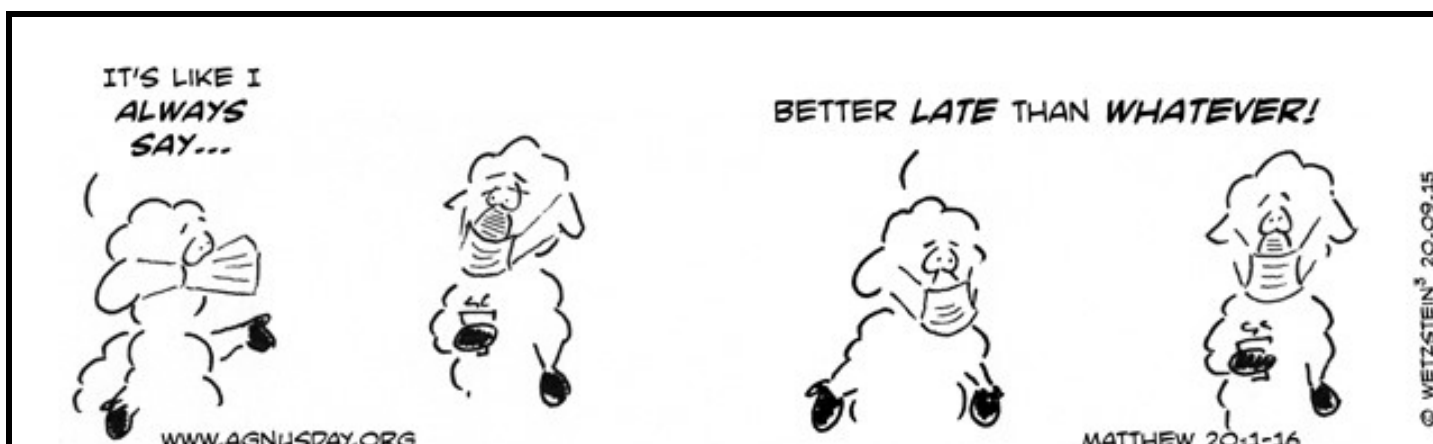

### Primate's World Relief & Development Fund (PWRDF)

After high school, Jessica Lazare of Kahnawake, Quebec enrolled in the two-year adult immersion program at Kanien'kehaka Onkwawén:na Raotiohkwa Language and Cultural Centre (KORLCC), supported by PWRDF. “The language itself is like a living entity. It changes the way you see yourself and it changes the way you see the world,” she said. She is now studying a double major at Concordia University in First Peoples Studies and Canadian and Québec policy studies. Dozens of people have graduated from KORLCC's program since it started in 2002 and are now language educators or project leaders.
