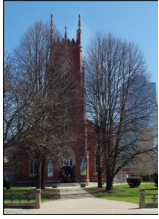
**Interested in being a worship assistant?** We are especially in need of ushers at this time. Please contact the office if you are interested.

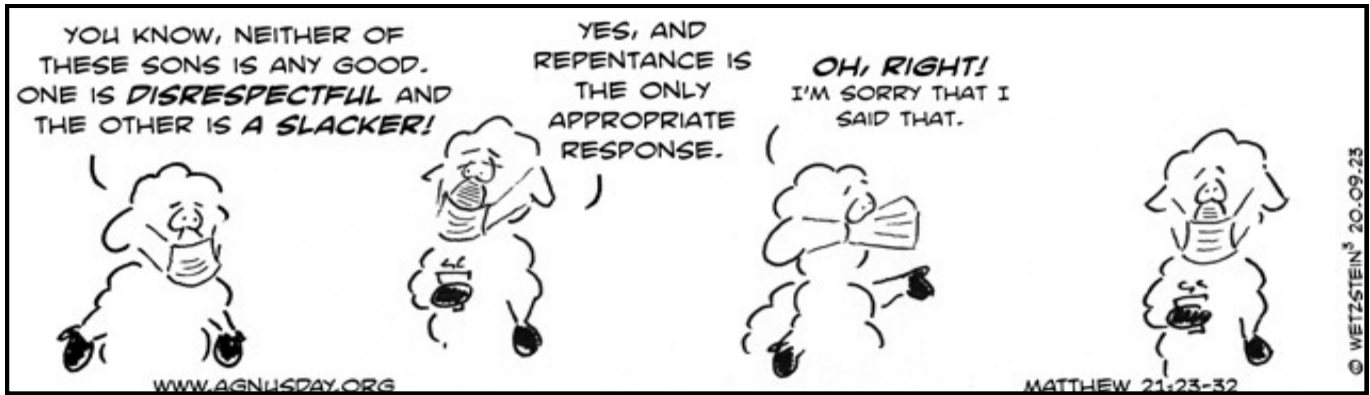

## Primate's World Relief & Development Fund (PWRDF)

After high school, Jessica Lazare of Kahnawake, Quebec enrolled in the two-year adult immersion program at Kanien'kehaka Onkwawén:na Raotitiohkwa Language and Cultural Centre (KORLCC), supported by PWRDF. "The language itself is like a living entity. It changes the way you see yourself and it changes the way you see the world," she said. She is now studying a double major at Concordia University in First Peoples Studies and Canadian and Québec policy studies. Dozens of people have graduated from KORLCC's program since it started in 2002 and are now language educators or project leaders.
